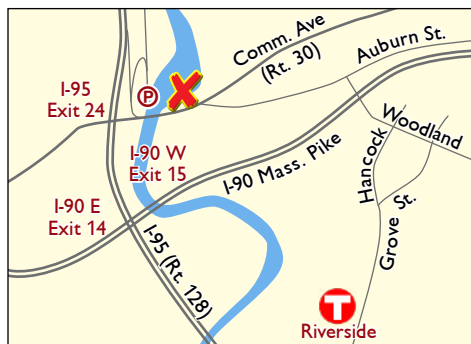

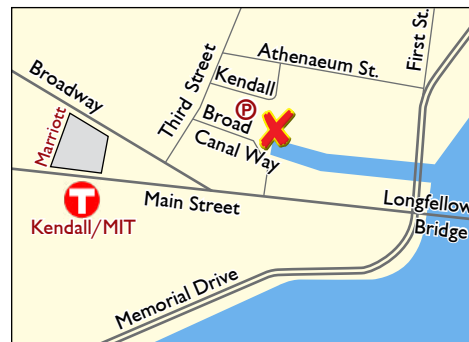
The Charles River here has no current, allowing painless round trips. Renters can also enjoy one-way trips to or from our location in Kendall Square, Cambridge.

- Driver's License or other legal I.D. is required to rent a boat.
- Rates include paddles and life jackets for adults and children of all ages.
- You must be at least 18 years of age to rent a boat (16 with parental signature on rental waiver); children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- All participants 16 and older must sign a waiver of liability stating that they are aware of the risks involved and are not under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Reservations are accepted only for groups renting eight boats or more. Please see our information on group outings at PaddleBoston.com
